

VINCENT E. TABER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

GUIDELINES AND QUALIFICATIONS

The Vincent E. Taber Memorial Scholarship is an award made annually to a qualified student based on the following guidelines and qualifications:

1. One scholarship award in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) will be made annually as long as sufficient funds are available in the account.
2. The Regional Board of Directors/ executive committee will review applications and make the final decision as to the recipient.
3. Preference will be given to students of need accepted at Berkshire Institute for Christian Studies. Award monies will be directly applied to student's account.
4. The application must be received by September 15th of any year and the award will be made prior to the start of the school year.

Qualifications

1. The applicant must be a member in good standing of an Advent Christian Church or other evangelical church.
2. The applicant must be of sound Christian character and provide a letter of recommendation from his/her pastor.
3. The applicant must provide a brief statement of personal testimony and sense of call to Christian service.
4. The applicant must be able to demonstrate financial need by providing information on anticipated annual costs along with expected sources of income.
5. The applicant must provide a transcript of last completed year of schooling.
